live in and all the premises thereto belonging to her and her
heirs and not to be given to any one out of the family and
after my decease I give to my four children (that is to say)
Thomas Richard Samuel and Elizabeth all my Goods and
that I have in possession to be equally divided between
them and I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my
son Thomas Tranter Executor of this my last Will and
Testament whereby making all former Wills by me at any time
heretofore made and declared this only to be my last Will
In Witness whereof I have to this my last Will and
Testament in the presence of us and in his presence also
being present and set my hand and seal this 23rd day of January

published and declared by the said Edward Tranter as and for
his last Will and Testament in the presence of us and in
