

The last Will and Testament of me Joseph Helliwell of Nether Bradfield Parish of Ecclesfield County of York I devise and bequeath to Charles Sanderson son of my sister Mary Sanderson subject to the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses the whole of my personal estate and effects namely household furniture live and dead farming stock tillages working tools of which I may die possessed and also the whole of my one third part or share in the freehold land called Gillott Fields situate near Nether Bradfield aforesaid and the several dwelling houses and shops situate at Nether Bradfield I devise and bequeath the whole of my share or third part in these to the aforesaid Charles Sanderson subject to the payment thereof of forty pounds to Henry Sanderson son of my sister Mary Sanderson One moiety or Twenty pounds of the said legacy to be paid to him twelve months after my decease - the other half or Twenty pounds at the expiration of three years from my decease I hereby appoint my brother Zacharias Sanderson and the aforesaid Charles Sanderson -
Executors of this my Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my name this second day of April One thousand eight hundred sixty eight - Joseph Helliwell - Signed by the said Joseph Helliwell in the presence of us present at the same time who in his presence and in the presence of each other attest and subscribe our names as witnesses hereto - Joseph Ibbotson Low Bradfield - Charles Barrott Low Bradfield. //

Proved at Wakefield the 27th day of May 1869 by the oaths of Zacharias Sanderson and Charles Sanderson the Executors to whom administration was granted.

The Testator Joseph Helliwell was late of Nether Bradfield in the Chapelry of Bradfield in the parish of Ecclesfield in the County of York Cutler and Farmer and died on the 18th day of February 1869 at Nether Bradfield aforesaid.
